



# SCHOOL UNIFORM GUIDE

For Parents, Carers and Families

We have an attractive and practical uniform of specially embroidered Navy blue sweatshirts, fleeces, coats, hats and white or light blue polo shirts. We ask that all children wear uniform, either the St Martin and St Mary uniform (available through links on our website – see below) or generic uniform available from supermarkets and chain stores. Please name everything.

We also ask that long hair is tied back, both for safety reasons and to stop the transfer of head lice (when they are present in school). We also insist that children don't wear jewellery to school, this is again for safety reasons and to avoid precious items going missing and being lost. If children have their ears pierced they are permitted to wear simple studs that must be removed for PE, swimming and outdoor learning sessions.

**PE and Games Kit** – children attend school in their PE kit on PE and Games days.

*N.B. We expect all children to wear our agreed school uniform for **PE and Games**. Please do not send children to school in Football Kits and 'Active Wear' with sport logos, aerobics outfits etc. Shorts must be an appropriate length.*

- ✓ Tracksuit - tops and bottoms
- ✓ Hoodie in house team colours
- ✓ Running vest
- ✓ Sports socks
- ✓ Waterproof sports jacket
- ✓ Navy leotard
- ✓ Black gym shorts (please note that shorts must be an appropriate length and not hot pants)

The above kit will be worn at school competition & sports festivals.

All items of uniform including PE, swimming kit and book bags must be clearly labelled with the child's name.
