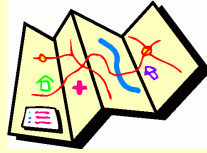


# Our Learning

## History

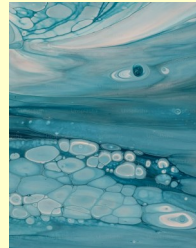

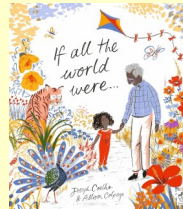
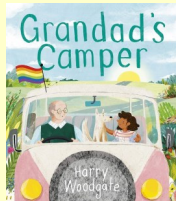
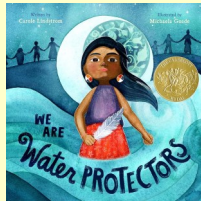
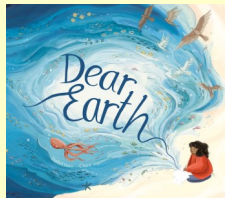
Listed below is the brief outline of our coverage across Spring Term for Year 1 and Year 2

## English

This term we will read, enjoy and do work around 4 different stories.

Dear Earth and We Are Water Protectors have a conservation focus about our natural world. We will be writing instructions, poems, persuasive speeches, letters and more.

Grandad's Camper and If All The World Were are stories with a focus on relationships and change. We will be writing postcards, top tips, diary entries and creating our very own interviews.

Year 2 will cover Money, Multiplication and Division, Time and will begin measurement.

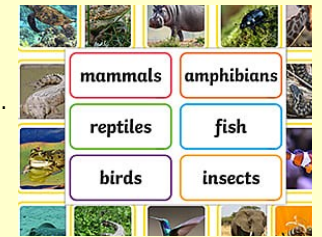


Your child will bring maths homework each Friday.

They are related to the Learning that has taken place that week. Homework is due back in every Friday.

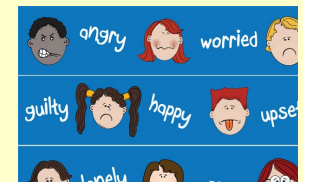
## Science
