Geography

In our Geography learning we will learn about the United Kingdom. We will find out about the 4 countries and their capital cities. Also, learn about the surrounding seas around the UK.



History

Computing

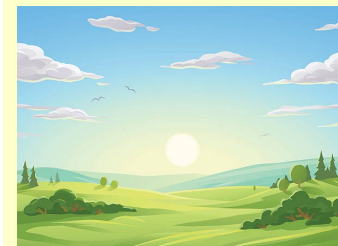
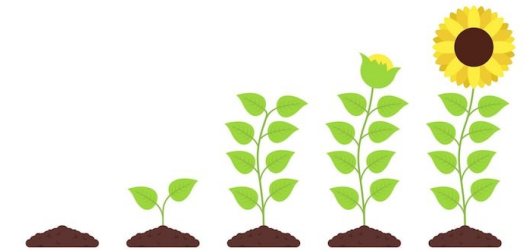
This term we look at Digital Writing to create and change text on a computer. Then we will introduce the children to ScratchJr, where they can programme sprites to move.

Our Learning

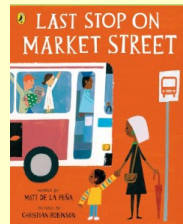
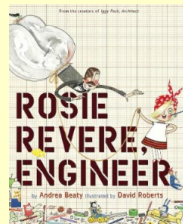
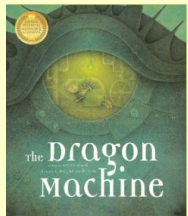
Listed below is the brief outline of our coverage across Spring Term for Year 1 and Year 2

English

This term we will read, enjoy and do work around 4 different stories.

Our First 2 stories, The Dragon Machine and Lizzy and the Cloud are linked to the theme of Fictional worlds & Fantasy. We will be writing dragon guides and encyclopaedia, shopping lists, descriptions, markets stall pitches and letters and advice.

Rosie Revere, Engineer and Last Stop on Market Street are stories with a focus on Urban Metropolis. We will be writing invention descriptions, advertisements, letter of advice, school report, metaphor poetry, interview questions and senses poetry.



Your child will bring spellings home each Friday.

They are related to the

Phonic sounds/ spelling patterns taught that week. You can help your child by putting these words into context and sentences.

Spelling Tests will take place on a Friday.



In Year one and Year two we love reading and like to hear your child read both on a one to one basis and during our whole class reading sessions.

It is important that your child reads regularly at home and brings their reading book and Home school record book each day.
