I can talk about what I would like to write.

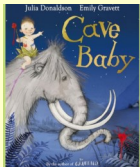
I can use my knowledge of phonics to attempt to spell new words.

Year 1 Maths

I can count in 2, 3 and 5 from 0 and in tens from any number.

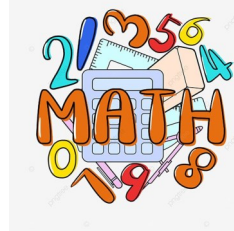
I can read, write and order numbers to 100, use <, > and = signs.
