- Providing timely advice and support across the continuum of need, from early help to statutory intervention
- Providing model policies and good practice guidance
- Establishing DSL and DDSL networks and training to support them to develop and embed a robust safeguarding practice and ethos
- Resolving complaints and Ofsted notifications
- Disseminating key safeguarding information and delivery of specialist training on a range of safeguarding issues
- To lead on the development of whole school and governing bodies/board of trustees safeguarding audits to evaluate the effectiveness of safeguarding arrangements within all education settings to identify good practice and areas for improvement
- To support the work of the WFSCP subgroups as required including the KSCiE core group
