For pupils, parents & coaches.

St Martin & St Mary Church of England Primary School encourages parents, guardians & spectators to take an active interest in their child's development within sport and ask that

every parent/guardian/spectator observe the following:

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, learning from every performance, **not just results!**
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements and trust experienced coaching decisions.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to understand the enjoyment of sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.

All our coaches must:

- Consider the well-being and safety of participants before the development of performance.
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with performers, based on mutual trust and respect.
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part.
- Promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play).
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance.
- Follow all guidelines laid down by the national governing body and the school.
- Never exert undue influence over performers to obtain personal benefit or reward.
- Ensure all Health & Safety Regulations are upheld at all times.

As a member of St Martin & St Mary Church of England Primary School you are expected to abide by the following rules:

- All pupils must play within the rules and respect officials/coaches and their decisions.
- All pupils must respect opponents.
- All pupils must wear the correct kit at all times.
- All pupils must ensure they give apologies for absence from a club.
- All pupils must ensure they have both a drink & one healthy snack before a club commences.
- All pupils must report any injuries to their coach at the start of the training session.
- **No jewellery to be worn! No earrings will be allowed!**
- Club payments must be paid up to date and handed in in a signed envelope.
- All pupils must ensure that 110% effort is given at all times! **HAVE FUN!**
